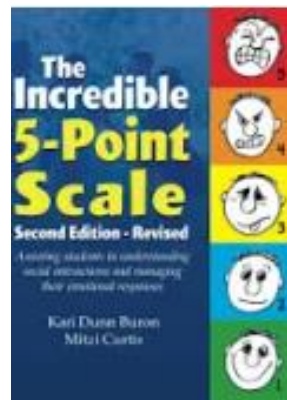
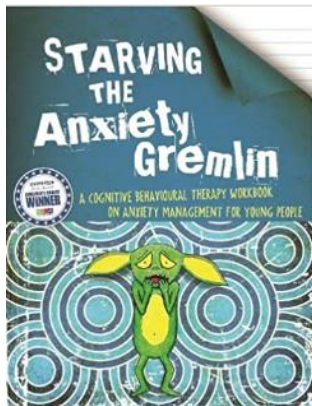


Parent Forum Minutes

SEND Forum:

- Parent has recently purchased 'Starving the Anxiety Gremlin' and 'The Incredible 5-point Scale: Assisting Students in Understanding Social Emotional Responses.' Parent will report back on how useful the books are, with a view to school purchasing them in the future



- School shared that the following support is available in through school:
 - Starlight Programme: Low level emotional health intervention led by School Nurse
 - In school interventions e.g. Milo and Hamish intervention – an emotional health intervention programme: https://hamishandmilo.org/?gclid=EAlaIQobChMIn7iY9c-y-gIVGevtCh1gaQ9TEAAYASAAEgLOZPD_BwE and 'TalkAbout' - a social communication intervention package
 - Alternative Provision Days at a local primary school: well-being and outdoor learning
 - Mental Health School Practitioner based in school one day a week from January 2023
 - 'Solution Circle' model used with school staff
 - Mental Health Lead and Pastoral Team – school-based staff

SEND Actions:

1. School to investigate how to refer pupils as 'young carers' when a sibling has a diagnosed condition, such as ASD.

General Actions:

1. 'Year at a Glance' to be displayed month by month in the external display cabinets
2. Any parent workshops to be videoed and uploaded to seesaw, for parents who are unable to attend
