We hold Collective Worship daily: Music and Worship; Whole School Worship (three times a week) and Class Worship. One core value and one branching value is explored each half term. The teachers and leaders lead most collective worships, and some are led by Liz, our Children and Families Lead for the Parish or by local clergy. Our peer elected 'Faith Ambassadors' help to lead worship sessions.

Celebrating with parents is an important and special time for us when we have whole school Celebration Assemblies on the last Friday of every month. We invite parents to celebrate their out of school achievements and children are presented with certificates. We say our Emmanuel Holcombe school prayer, with parents invited to join in.

The children regularly visit Emmanuel Holcombe Church where the children lead our services to celebrate major Christian festivals.

These include: Harvest Festival, Christmas Carol Service, Easter Service and End of School Year Service. We also hold our annual 'Celebration Sunday', which is a joint service with our sister school, St Mary's Hawkshaw. Children from both schools lead the service at St Mary's Church. Our school choir also help lead a Christmas Service at the Emmanuel Church Centre. This gives children the opportunity to visit all three of our Parish churches. Parents, grandparents, siblings and Governors join us on these occasions.

Members of the clergy and church congregation lead 'Experience Christmas' and 'Experience Easter', in church, where children participate in a carousel of activities. Children also enjoy 'Prayer Spaces', again led by members of the church. Our pupils very much enjoy going into church and see it as an extension of their school.
