## **Record of Governors Finance Meeting**

- 1. Opened the meeting in prayer.
- 2. Apologies were received from PS for lateness to the meeting.
- 3. The minutes of the last meeting were agreed as accurate.
- 4. Matters arising from the meeting:
- Budget 22-23: A balanced budget has been set
- Administration staff pay is now aligned based on current job description and job share
- Cubs to be invoiced for using the hall
- It was suggested that we have a Governors' working party to look at Recruitment and staffing costs
- AL requested we purchase CPOMs, which is a digital Safeguarding device and builds a chronological picture of the child. This was agreed for both pupils and staff
- 5. Staffing update:

- Temporary increase of TA hours
- Temporary class teacher cover
- There is still a vacancy for 1.5 days per week for EYFS. TA3 role to be advertised

- 0.5 temporary teacher needed for Sept. Advert to go out.
- Discussion took place regarding EHCP provision for September.
- Discussion around impact of splitting year groups for Maths rather than use the mixed aged planning.
- 6. Pre-school Policy was agreed in principle by the Governors. This will be sent out for Governors to ratify by email.
- 7. Paternity Leave to commence in September 2022
- 8. Land and Building Work:

- The climbing Wall and Tyres have to be removed

- There is a quote regarding building work at the front of school. A structural survey has been completed and the architect is obtaining 3 quotes
