# Our location

Situated on the side of Holcombe Hill above Ramsbottom lies Emmanuel Holcombe Church of England primary and preschool. The school was originally built in the village of Holcombe in 1864 to serve the local community.

We have direct access to Holcombe moor where we enjoy learning outdoors in our beautiful environment.

We have 3 outdoor learning areas within our school grounds which have amazing views across the valley, down into Manchester and on a clear day, views of the Derbyshire hills.

Our unique family feel at Emmanuel Holcombe extends from our ethos, that all children's talents and abilities are celebrated and nurtured. Our family atmosphere permeates school life, with children interacting with others through work and play. Our small school consists of 4 mixed aged classes offering education from pre-school to Year 6.

Together, our children, staff and parents share a love of learning, which enables all to flourish both academically and socially.



Our Emmanuel Holcombe curriculum is designed to enable our children to leave us in Year 6 with the knowledge, skills and experiences that they can build upon in high school and beyond, to foster a love of learning and to be an active citizen in society . Our curriculum covers all areas of the National Curriculum ,however, this only makes up part of our teaching. We ensure that our curriculum also covers physical, mental, spiritual, cultural and intellectual health . Every child in school is given the opportunity to question, take risks, work with a range of adults and make a meaningful contribution to the local community.

## Wrap around care

To support working parents and busy families, we offer wrap around care with our Breakfast Club and Afterschool Club named Peelers. Wrap around care is flexible and childcare vouchers can be used for payment.

#### Breakfast club from 7.30am

We offer a fully supervised breakfast club from 7.30am in the morning where children may have their breakfast with friends before the school day begins

## After School Club Until 6pm

We offer a fully supervised after school club which runs from the end of the school day until 6pm. Children enjoy a snack after school with friends and a cooked meal at 4.45pm.
